

GARNNY SQUARE CROSSBODY BAG (PDF)

MATERIALS YOU NEED

- Yarn — worsted weight (4) — cream/white color — 200g
- Yarn — worsted weight (4) — dark charcole color — 100g
- Crochet hook — 3.00mm
- Scissors
- Yarn needle for weaving ends
- 1 gold bag clasp or magnetic snap
- 1 gold D-ring for strap
- Stitch markers

start

round 1

Make a magicring.

Chain 3 (counts as first dc).

Make 14 dc into magic ring.

Slip stitch into top of chain 3 to join.

Pull magic ring closed.

Total: 15 stitches.



2ND ROUND

PUFF (

Step 1 Yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop — **3 loops on hook**

Step 2 Yarn over, insert hook into **SAME** stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop — **5 loops on hook**

Final Step 🌀 Yarn over, pull through **ALL 5 loops** on hook Chain 1 to secure — **DONE!**)

Chain 3.

Make one mini puff stitch in same stitch as join.

Chain 2.

Make one mini puff stitch in next stitch. Chain 2.

Repeat from * to * in each stitch around — **14 more times.**

Slip stitch to top of chain 3 to join.

Fasten off and weave in ends CHN1.

Total: 15 puff stitches with 15 chain 2 spaces.



3RD ROUND

DC3TOG (**DC3TOG** means **Double Crochet 3 Together.....**(**What it means:** It is a **decrease stitch** that joins 3 double crochets together into 1 stitch — reducing your stitch count by 2.)

How to do it Step by Step:

Step 1 Yarn over, insert hook into next stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops — you have 2 loops on hook

Step 2 Yarn over, insert hook into NEXT stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops — you have 3 loops on hook

Step 3 Yarn over, insert hook into NEXT stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops — you have 4 loops on hook

Step 4 Yarn over, pull through ALL 4 loops on hook — DONE!)

Join burgundy yarn in any chain 2 space from round 2.

:Ch 3, dc3tog, ch 2

DC3TOG ,2CH (REPEATED 15 TIME) ,SLST ,chain 1 ,cut

Total: 15 dc3tog clusters with 15 chain 2 spaces.



4TH ROUND in white

Join charcole yarn in any chain 2 space.

Chain 3. Make 2 dc in same space. (First side group made.)

Corner 1: In next chain 2 space make (3tr, chain 3, 3tr) all in same space.

Side: Make 3dc in each of next 3 chain 2 spaces.

Corner 2: In next chain 2 space make (3tr, chain 3, 3tr) all in same space.

Side: Make 3dc in each of next 3 chain 2 spaces.

Corner 3: In next chain 2 space make (3tr, chain 3, 3tr) all in same space.

Side: Make 3dc in each of next 3 chain 2 spaces.

Corner 4: In next chain 2 space make (3tr, chain 3, 3tr) all in same space.

Side: Make 3dc in each of next 3 chain 2 spaces.

Slip stitch into top of chain 3 to join. Chain 1.

Do NOT fasten off. Continue to Round 5.

Total: 4 corners + 4 sides of 9dc each.



5th round

Continue with charcole yarn. Do not join new yarn.

Slip stitch into next 2 dc to reach first corner space.

Corner 1: In corner chain 3 space make (3tr, chain 3, 3tr).

Side: Make 3dc in each dc group across the side — working into the top of each dc group from round 4.

Corner 2: In corner chain 3 space make (3tr, chain 3, 3tr).

Side: Make 3dc in each dc group across the side.

Corner 3: In corner chain 3 space make (3tr, chain 3, 3tr).

Side: Make 3dc in each dc group across the side.

Corner 4: In corner chain 3 space make (3tr, chain 3, 3tr).

Side: Make 3dc in each dc group across the side.

Slip stitch to join. Chain 1.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Total: 4 corners + 4 sides of 12dc each.



MOTIF COMPLETE.

Make 4 motifs total

FRONT 1 PIECES

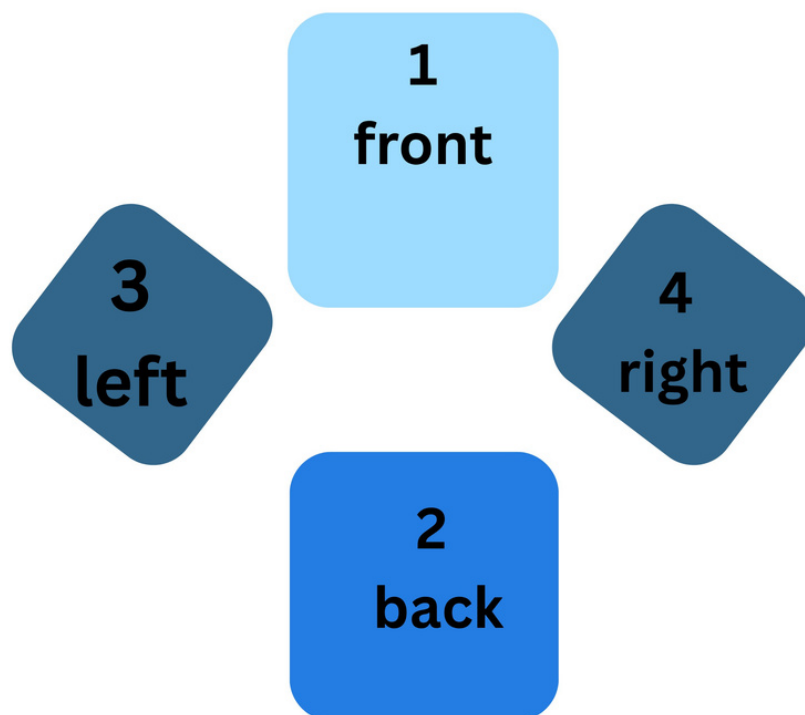
BACK 1 PIECES

RIGHT 1 PIECES

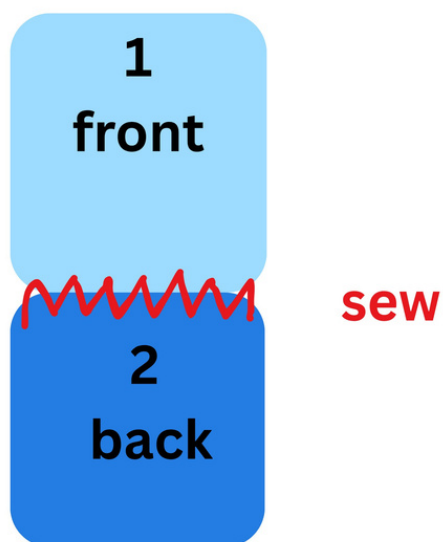
LEFT 1 PIECES

Granny Square Shoulder Bag — Assembly Instructions

How to arrange them:



step 1



Lay 3 motifs side by side in a horizontal row. Make sure all motifs face the same direction — burgundy flower center facing up on all of them.

step 2



sew

How to join them together:

Step 1 — Hold two motifs with wrong sides facing each other.

Step 2 — Join white yarn in the corner chain 3 space where the two motifs will meet. FROM BOTTOM

Step 3 — Using your yarn needle and white yarn whip stitch along the entire edge through the outer loops of both motifs at the same time.

Step 4 — When you reach the next corner chain 3 space fasten off and weave in end.

Step 5 — Join the third square to the second square the same way.

You now have one long rectangular panel of 3 joined squares.

— FOLD THE PANEL DIAGONALLY

This is the step that creates the beautiful curved crossbody bag shape.

Step 1 — Lay your joined panel flat on a table with the right side facing up.

Step 2 — Fold the panel diagonally — bring the bottom left corner up to meet the top right corner.

Step 3 — The panel now forms a triangle shape with the burgundy flower squares visible on the outside.

Step 4 — Pin all edges together to hold the fold in place.

Step 5 — The folded top edge becomes your bag opening — leave this completely open.

Step 6 — The two side edges and bottom curved edge will be sewn together in the next step

step 3



**sew on both side
to make curved**

— SEW THE EDGES TOGETHER

Step 1 — Join white yarn at the right side edge.

Step 2 — Whip stitch along the entire right side edge through both layers — sewing front and back together.

Step 3 — Continue whip stitching along the bottom curved edge.

Step 4 — Continue up the left side edge.

Step 5 — Stop when you reach the bag opening at the top — leave the top edge open.

Step 6 — Fasten off and weave in all ends securely.

Your bag body is now complete and has a beautiful crescent shape.



— TOP BORDER AND OPENING FINISH

This finishes the bag opening neatly and adds a professional look.

Join charcole yarn at top right corner of bag opening.

start from coner space

3chain ,2 double crochet in same space

3dc in next space (repeated all the way at the end where we start

in last space do 6 double crochet all in one ..

3 dc again all the way untill end ..

in last space do 3dc and then slst ..

(3dc from start ,3dc at end .total 6dc..)

place stitch marker ..single crochet in each stitch. slst ..donot cut yarn

now we have a clear boundery

ATTACH THE D-RINGS (crochet method)

You need 2 gold D-rings — one for each top corner of the bag opening.

For each D-ring:

Step 1 — Hold the D-ring in your non-dominant hand with the flat straight edge facing up.

Step 2 — Join white yarn to the flat straight edge of the D-ring with a slip stitch.

Step 3 — Single crochet tightly all the way along the flat straight edge of the D-ring — working your stitches directly over the metal bar. make only 3 single crochet in the D RING BRING

close to left side .

continue single crochet all the way until you reached at end corner ,place other ring at the corner do 6 sc in 6 stitch in D RING...

again continue single crochet all the way until you reached at end ,leave about 3 to 4 stitch and then bring the ring close and do single crochet and slst..

ATTACH THE STRAP

You have two options for the strap:

Option A — Adjustable chain strap

Purchase a gold adjustable chain strap with lobster clasp clips from any craft or bag hardware shop. Simply clip both lobster clasps onto your two D-rings. This gives a beautiful professional finish exactly like the image.

Option B — Crocheted strap

STARTING THE STRAP:

Attach yarn directly to the first swivel clasp. Work **6 sc** across the clasp bar. Turn.

ROW 1: Ch 1, sc in each st across — **6 sts** Turn.

Repeat Row 1 until strap reaches your desired length. (*120cm for crossbody/60cm for shoulder bag*)

FINISHING THE STRAP:

Do NOT fasten off.

Attach the second swivel clasp to the working end. Work **6 sc** across the second clasp bar, joining to your last row.

Fasten off. Weave in all ends neatly.

NOTES:

- Count your stitches every few rows — always **6 sts**
- Keep tension even throughout for a flat, neat strap
- Block lightly with steam iron for best results

zipper part

take the zipper of white colour and sew...
