

SUNFLOWER CROWN HEADBAND - COMPLETE CROCHET PATTERN

PRODUCT INFORMATION

Skill Level: Beginner to Intermediate Time to Complete: 4-6 hours Finished Size: Adjustable (fits most adults) Perfect For: Weddings, festivals, gift giving, everyday wear, summer events

Easy Sunflower Crochet Pattern

This simple flower has:

- 1 dark brown center
- 6 golden yellow petals
- Finished flower size: approximately 2½–3 inches (6–8 cm)

MATERIALS

- **Golden Yellow yarn** (for petals)
- **Dark Brown yarn** (for center)
- 4 mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

ABBREVIATIONS

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- dc = double crochet
- sl st = slip stitch
- st = stitch

TOOLS & HARDWARE:

- 4mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- 2 hair clips OR 1 elastic hair tie
- 1 gold chain (optional, for center connection)
- Small beads (optional, for flower centers)
- Stitch markers

QUANTITY: Make 10-12 maximum, 9-10 minimum (or as you want) flowers total

FLOWER CENTER (Dark Brown)

Round 1

1. Make a magic ring.
2. Work 12 sc into the ring.
3. Pull the ring closed.
4. Join with a sl st to the first sc. **(12 sts)**

Round 2

1. Ch 1.
2. Work 2 sc in each stitch around.
3. Join with a sl st. **(24 sts)**

Fasten off dark brown yarn.

PETALS (Golden Yellow) - Make 6

Step 1:

Attach golden yellow yarn to any stitch on the dark brown center with sc

Step 2:

Ch 4 (this forms the petal base)

Step 3:

Make Treble Crochet Cluster in same stitch:

- Yarn over twice, insert hook in stitch, yarn over and pull through
- You now have 3 loops on hook
- Yarn over and pull through 2 loops
- Yarn over and pull through remaining 2 loops
- Repeat this process 2 more times in the same stitch (3 treble clusters total)
- Yarn over and pull through all 4 loops on hook

Step 4:

Ch 4, slip stitch in next stitch to complete petal

Step 5:

Repeat Steps 2-4 five more times around the center (6 petals total)

Step 6:

Fasten off and weave in ends

MAKE SUNFLOWER AS YOU WANT AND COLORS YOU WANT

SECTION 2: MAKE THE HEADBAND BASE

Option A: Chain Base (Flexible)

1. With golden yellow yarn, ch 100-120
2. Fasten off, leaving long tails (8+ inches on each end)
3. This becomes the flexible headband base

Option B: Elastic Base (Adjustable)

1. Use 1-inch wide elastic hair tie
2. This provides natural stretch and comfort

SECTION 3: ASSEMBLE THE HEADBAND

Step 1: Plan Flower Placement

1. Lay out all finished sunflowers
2. Arrange 9-12 flowers in a circle/crown pattern
3. Space flowers approximately 2-3 inches apart
4. Place largest/most perfect flowers in front center

Step 2: Attach Flowers to Base

Method 1 - Chain Base:

1. Using tapestry needle and yarn tail
2. Sew first flower securely to center of chain
3. Work outward, alternating left and right sides
4. Sew flowers evenly spaced along the chain
5. Knot securely after each flower attachment

Method 2 - Elastic Base:

1. Use yarn needle to sew flowers directly to elastic band
2. Space flowers evenly around the band
3. Make 2-3 passes through each flower base to secure
4. Knot yarn securely between flowers

Step 3: Attach Hair Clips

For Chain Base:

1. Attach first hair clip to one end of chain
2. Attach second clip to other end
3. Sew securely with needle and thread
4. Test to ensure clips grip hair firmly

For Elastic Base:

1. Attach elastic ends to hair clips
2. OR wear directly as elastic headband

3. Secure with small stitches

Step 4: Final Adjustments

1. Try on headband
2. Ensure flowers sit properly on head
3. Adjust flower positions if needed
4. Check all flowers are secure
5. Weave in any remaining yarn tails

STYLING OPTIONS:

✓ **With Braid:** Wrap headband over French braid ✓ **With Updo:** Wear on top of bun or twisted updo ✓ **With Down Hair:** Position across top of wavy/straight hair ✓ **Half-Up Style:** Wear over half-up, half-down hair ✓ **Side Position:** Wear slightly to one side for asymmetrical look

CUSTOMIZATION OPTIONS

Color Variations:

Option 1 - Classic Sunflower:

- Golden yellow petals, dark brown center, gold chain

Option 2 - Pale Sunflower:

- Pale yellow petals, light brown center

Option 3 - Sunset Sunflower:

- Orange-yellow petals, dark brown center

Option 4 - Mixed Sunflower Garden:

- Mix golden, pale, and orange-yellow petals with brown centers

Option 5 - Summer Bride Sunflower:

- All golden yellow flowers, brown centers, pearl accents

Size Adjustments:

- **More Flowers:** Add 2-3 additional flowers for fuller look
- **Fewer Flowers:** Use 5-6 flowers for delicate, minimalist style
- **Larger Flowers:** Use thicker yarn (bulky weight)
- **Smaller Flowers:** Use thinner yarn (sport weight)

Additional Details:

✓ Add small brown beads in flower centers ✓ Add green leaves between flowers ✓ Add green ribbon hanging from sides ✓ Add lace trim along base ✓ Add pearls or rhinestones for formal events

TROUBLESHOOTING:

Issue	Solution
Flowers drooping	Reinforce stitches, tighten yarn tension
Clips slipping	Use larger clips, add textured tape to grip
Flowers falling off	Add extra knots, double-stitch attachment
Uneven appearance	Adjust flower positions, use starch if needed
Yarn fading	Store away from sunlight, use UV protection

MINI SUNFLOWER - SHORT VERSION

Scaled Down by 50% - Perfect for Small Projects

MATERIALS

- Golden yellow yarn (small amount)
- Dark brown yarn (small amount)
- 3.5mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Finished Size: 0.75-1 inch (tiny & delicate)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain | sc = single crochet | sl st = slip stitch | tr = treble crochet | YO = yarn over

FLOWER CENTER (Dark Brown)

Round 1:

- Magic ring
- Ch 1, work 6 sc into ring (reduced from 12)
- Sl st to join **(6 sts)**

Round 2:

- Ch 1
- Work 2 sc in each st around
- Sl st to join **(12 sts)**

Fasten off dark brown, leave 3-inch tail

PETALS (Golden Yellow) - Make 6

1. Join golden yellow yarn with sc to center
2. Ch 4
3. Make 2 treble clusters in same stitch (reduced from 3)
4. Ch 4
5. Sl st to next stitch
6. Repeat 5 more times around

Fasten off golden yellow, leave 3-inch tail

Weave in ends
